Directions to the Conference Office (The Pennell Center)

Maine Conference UCC, is located approximately 15 miles North of Portland in the town of Yarmouth. Routes 1 and 95 go directly through Yarmouth.

From the North on Rt. 95 take Exit 17 onto Rt. 1. Go through three traffic lights and take first right to Rt. 115 (Main Street, Yarmouth). Take a right onto Main Street. Take first right (Yarmouth Crossing Drive) after the Irving Gas Station - and the Conference office is located second building on your left (28 Yarmouth Crossing Drive). Brick Front with wooden ramp - use middle door.

From the South on Rt. 95 take Exit 15 onto Rt. 1 - go over two overpasses and take right to Rt. 115 (Main Street, Yarmouth). Take a right onto Main Street - Take first right (Yarmouth Crossing Drive) after Irving Gas Station - Conference office is located second building on your left (28 Yarmouth Crossing Drive). Brick Front with wooden ramp - use middle door. Located behind CURVES.

The emblem of the United Church of Christ is based on the ancient Christian symbol known as the Cross of Victory or the Cross Triumphant.

Traditionally, this symbol - the cross surmounted by the crown and all of it atop the orb - signifies the kingship of the Risen Christ over all the world. The orb, representing the world, is divided into three parts to signify the command of our Lord to his disciples: "You shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the end of the earth."

For the United Church of Christ this emblem, rich in the future traditions of the past and alive with hope for the future, is particularly appropriate. For this reason, there appears on the perimeter of the emblem both the name of the church and the text: "That they may all be one."

Directions to Pilgrim Lodge

*Be advised: Interstate route numbers and exit numbers have changed.
These directions reflect the new numbering system.*

Pilgrim Lodge is situated on the eastern shore of Lake Cobbosseecontee in West Gardiner, Maine, on an unnumbered route, (the Neck Road) about 12 miles southwest of Augusta.

Traveling North:

From the Maine Turnpike (Interstate 95)
take exit 102, turn **Right** onto Route 126.

OR From I-295 take exit 51, turn **Left** on Route 126.

Follow Route 126 about 2.5 miles. / turn **RIGHT** onto "Spears Corner Road at the blinking light)
/Continue straight for 4.3 miles, (through 2 stop signs) to a third stop sign. **careful: cross traffic does NOT stop at any of the three stop signs/** At that third stop sign turn **Left** onto Neck Road/ Pilgrim Lodge will be one mile ahead on your **Right**.

Traveling South

From I-95, take exit 109 B onto **Route 202** west. Follow below

Traveling West: Travel through Augusta on **Route 202**, cross over I-95

After 2.5 miles, (by the Manchester Texaco), at the stoplight where route 17 turns right (don't turn right) and 202 goes straight (don't go straight) turn **LEFT** onto **Pond Road** / Proceed South for about 6.5 miles. Pilgrim Lodge will be on your right.

DIRECTIONS TO ROCKCRAFT

FROM THE NORTH OR SOUTH: Leave the turnpike at Exit 11 in Gray. Turn left onto Rt. 115 for about 6 miles into North Windham at first light. Go straight across onto Rt. 35 for approx. 7 miles. You will enter Sebago Lake Village four corners. Take right onto Rt. 114. Rockcraft is on your right approx. 8.3 miles.

FROM PORTLAND: Take #25 through Westbrook to Gorham. Then take a right (north) in Gorham at a traffic light on Rt. 114 (for about 8 miles) till you reach #35 and 114. (A 4 way stop sign) Stay on #114, Rockcraft is 8.3 miles from that junction, on your right.

FROM THE NORTH: Leave the turnpike at Exit 11 at Gray. At the tollbooth bear to the left on #115. Travel to North Windham (about 6 miles) to a stoplight. Go through that stop light (straight head). You will now be on #35. Follow #35 (about 7 miles) to the junction with #114 (a 4 way stop sign). At this junction you turn to your right (north) on #114. You are 8.3 miles from Rockcraft on your right.

FROM NEW HAMPSHIRE: Come through Fryeburg on #302 until you reach Naples, take a right on #114. (You are 10.5 miles from Rockcraft on your left.)

What Our Name, United Church of Christ, Signifies

The United Church of Christ is a united and uniting church. Each of the communions which came together to form the United Church of Christ in 1957 had itself come into being through the union of two denominations. Therefore church union and Christian unity are in the very bloodstream of our people.

The United Church is a church of Christ. We believe that we are called to carry out his mission in the world today. Wherever there are people without the gospel, wherever there are people in need, wherever there is injustice, strife, hatred, and greed - there the United Church of Christ is bound by its Lord to bear witness, to serve, to help, to reconcile, to rebuild. We belong to Christ and we must follow where he leads.

The United Church of Christ is a free church and a responsible church. No one dictates to a local church concerning the decisions it makes. Freedom is guaranteed. But it is "freedom in the gospel" and assumes that every corporate body within the church, whether a local church or a conference or the General Synod, will make its decisions in the light of the gospel and out of a sense of responsibility to the whole fellowship.

The United Church of Christ is a church of the people. The church is not clergy, nor is it the organization at the regional or national levels; nor is it the officers or boards, commissions or councils, though all play their important and indispensable parts. The church is people gathered for worship, work, and witness. The local and regional mission and the wider mission to the nation and the world through the instrumentalities of the denomination are made possible by the response of persons to the task and witness entrusted to us together as people of God.

We aim here to set forth in brief compass the varied religious traditions represented in the United Church. We also present our Statement of Faith and describe the instrumentalities through which our local churches and their members lengthen their outreach and express their love toward other human beings and their service in Christ's name.

"For all the saints" whose Christian labor and loyalty in times past have made possible our work and witness now, we give thanks to God. God's love in Christ as we experience it in this fellowship calls us also to the full commitment of our lives in redemptive and reconciling service.
